Expressions of Interest now open

Independent artists, artist collectives and arts organisations are invited to submit project proposals for the 2019 Nannup Music Festival's Sculpture by the Tree.

Set in the creative oasis of the Arboretum and with a potential audience of thousands over the festival weekend this is a perfect opportunity to have your work seen and possibly sold.

The 2019 Sculpture by the Tree will be promoted through the Festival website, social media and festival program.

Artist Brief

The Festival seeks temporary or ephemeral artwork proposals for installation in the Arboretum area. There is no limitation in materials provided that they pose no threat or hazard to the environment or the public.

Previously exhibited or older work is eligible for entry. Work previously exhibited at the NMF Art Walk or anywhere in Nannup is ineligible.

One entry per artist will be accepted. Ten entries will be shortlisted for exhibition at the 2019 Sculpture by the Tree.

Prize

We're introducing a \$500 non-acquisitive cash prize, which will be awarded to the best entry (independent jury TBA).

Timeframe

The 2019 Nannup Music Festival will take place from 1st – 4th March 2019.

The artworks must be exhibition ready by Thursday 28 February 2019 and remain installed for the duration of the Festival.

Schedule

Expressions of Interest close:

5pm Tuesday, 31 December 2019

Notification Date:

Shortlisted artists will be notified by January 2nd 2019.

Install:

Thursday 28 February 2019 by 5pm

Deinstall:

Monday 4 March 2019 by 1pm

Considerations

Safety

Artworks must be able to withstand the weather, wear and tear.

The Festival cannot provide 24 hour security for the artworks. Artists participate at their own risk.

Artworks should pose no threat or hazard to the environment and the public. Please also keep in mind that the Festival runs during a total fire ban.

Durability

Artworks must be able to last the duration of the Festival.

Install & Deinstall

Artists are responsible for timely install & deinstall. The site must be returned to its original condition by the artist.

Maintenance

The artist must be available or at least contactable for maintenance issues that might arise. If the artwork is damaged beyond repair and the artist has chosen not to attend the Festival and is uncontactable, the Festival reserves the right to remove the artwork.

Walkthroughs

Walkthroughs are recommended but not obligatory. To arrange one, please contact us at info@nannupmusicfestival.org.

Fees

The 10 shortlisted artists will be asked to contribute an entry fee of \$50.

Each artist/organisation will be entitled to one complimentary Adult Weekend Festival Ticket (valued at \$190) and a complimentary Camping Weekend Ticket (valued at \$60).

A 20% commission will be retained by the Festival for artwork sales.

Submission Requirements

1. Name and contact details of artist or organisation.
2. Artwork title.

3. CV of lead artist or organisation mission statement.

4. Artwork description/concept drawings, list of materials used, technical specifications. Please include artwork dimensions and weight, footing and anchoring details.

5. Support material (photos, video, website link, etc.).
